

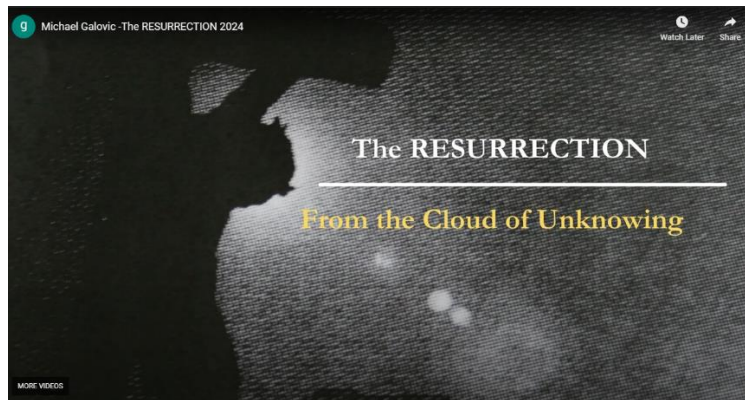
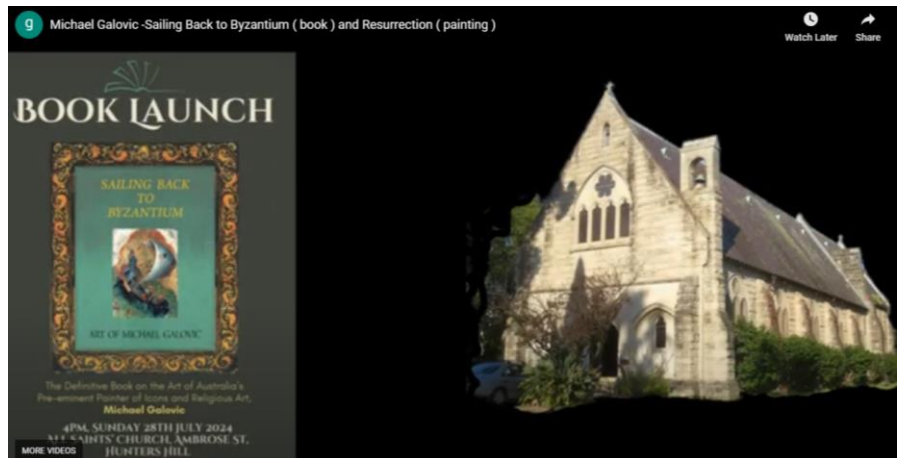
Sailing Back to Byzantium
